Harvard University School of Law is part of the Harvard University located in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA. These classroom applications feature the DIS DM4121P units connected to custom stainless steel microphone plates mounted on the desk top and custom stainless steel speaker plates located in the edge of the table.

There are a total of three classrooms in Austin Hall using the DIS system. The professors have the option of operating each system either push-to-talk or voice-activated, selectable from an AMX panel mounted in the front of the classroom. The systems are also used for both sound re-enforcement and for teleconference/distant learning applications.
